## **President of Seminary to Speak at Christ Covenant Sunday School Class**

Dr. Michael A. Milton to teach at a Sunday School Class for Christ Covenant Church, in Charlotte

[Charlotte, NC—August 25, 2009]—Dr. Michael A. Milton, President and Professor of Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC, will speak at a Christ Covenant Church Sunday School class in Charlotte on Sunday, August 30 at 9 a.m. The topic for the morning will be a Reformed perspective on evangelism.

Christ Covenant Church was established in 1983 as a mission of the Central Carolina Presbytery and a daughter church of Briarwood Presbyterian Church in Birmingham, Al. Today the campus includes eight buildings and a total of 120,000 square feet including the Sanctuary which seats 2,000 for services. From its small beginning with just four families, Christ Covenant has grown to a current membership of more than 2,350 communing members and children.

Among the church's associated ministries are Campus Outreach, now on five college and university campuses in this region and in South Africa where they serve on three campuses; SOAR youth sports outreach reaching almost 1,000 children each season, and Covenant Day School with an enrollment of more than 800 students in grades K through 12.

Formerly Senior Pastor of the historic First Presbyterian Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Milton also founded two churches and a school. Once an executive with two Fortune 500 companies, he was also a top-secret linguist in the Navy. He accepted the call to become President of Reformed Theological Seminary in November 2007. Dr. Milton is the author of 9 books including his autobiography *What God Starts, God Completes: Help and Hope for Hurting People* (Christian Focus Publications, 2007). His teaching can be heard on select radio stations in the US and over the Internet at [www.thecall.rts.edu](http://www.thecall.rts.edu). Milton often illustrates his sermons through original songs and has released two CDs on the label Music for Missions called "He Shall Restore" and "Follow Your Call" available through iTunes. He resides in the Charlotte area with his wife and son.

Reformed Theological Seminary is one of the largest seminaries in the nation, with campuses in Charlotte, Jackson, Orlando, Atlanta, and Washington DC.
