## President of Seminary to Preach at First Presbyterian Church

Dr. Michael A. Milton to teach at First Presbyterian Church, in Jackson, MS

[Charlotte, NC—January 22, 2010]—Dr. Michael A. Milton, President and James M. Baird, Jr. Professor of Pastoral Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC, will be preaching at a Men's Rally at First Presbyterian Church, in Jackson, MS. on Friday January 29. Dinner will be served at 5:15 with preaching sessions at 6:30 and 8 pm. Dr. Milton will also be preaching at the Sunday morning service at 11 am.

First Presbyterian Church was founded in 1837 and has a long and rich history of serving the community of Jackson, MS. The 25<sup>th</sup> annual Men's Rally is an opportunity for fathers and grandfathers to spend quality time with their sons and grandsons. It is a time to invite both Christian and non-Christian friends, neighbors, colleagues, and acquaintances to an uplifting gathering of men from around the state and region.

Former Senior Pastor of the historic First Presbyterian Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Milton also founded two churches and a school. Prior to his call to the ministry, he was an executive with two Fortune 500 companies, and a top-secret linguist in the Navy. He accepted the call to become President of Reformed Theological Seminary in November 2007. Dr. Milton is the author of nine books including his autobiography *What God Starts, God Completes: Help and Hope for Hurting People* (Christian Focus Publications, 2007). Milton often illustrates his sermons with original songs and has released two CDs on the label Music for Missions called "He Shall Restore" and "Follow Your Call" available through iTunes. He resides in the Charlotte area with his wife and son.
