President of Seminary to Speak in Germany

Dr. Michael A. Milton to be Keynote Speaker at PRJC & Friends Chaplain Family Retreat

[GARMISCH, GERMANY—February 26, 2009]—Dr. Michael A. Milton, President and Professor of Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC, will be the keynote speaker at the Presbyterian & Reformed Joint Commission (PRJC) and Friends Chaplain Family retreat in Garmisch, Germany, beginning Friday, March 13, and continuing through Monday, March 16. The conference is being held at the Edelweiss Lodge and Resort in Garmisch and will be attended by US military chaplains and their wives who are stationed in Europe.

Dr. Milton will preach four sermons taken from various passages of the Pastoral Epistles. The theme of his messages is “Sustained by God’s Grace to be Used for God’s Glory: Essentials for Ministry and Missions from the Pastoral Epistles.” The sermons will deal with theological and pastoral issues that all chaplains face.

Former Senior Pastor of the historic First Presbyterian Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Milton also founded two churches and a Christian school. Before attending seminary he was an executive with two Fortune 500 companies, and a top-secret linguist in the Navy. In November 2007 he accepted the call to become President of Reformed Theological Seminary. Dr. Milton is the author of 9 books including his autobiography: *What God Starts, God Completes: Help and Hope for Hurting People* (Christian Focus Publications, 2007). His teaching can be heard on select radio stations in the US and over the Internet at www.thecall.rts.edu. Milton often illustrates his sermons with original songs. Music for Missions has released two CDs, "He Shall Restore" and "Follow Your Call", also available through iTunes. He resides in the Charlotte area with his wife and son.
