President of Seminary to Teach in Monterrey, Mexico

Dr. Michael A. Milton to Teach Church Planting Course in Mexico

[MONTERREY, MEXICO—January 6, 2009]—Dr. Michael A. Milton, President and Professor of Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC, will teach a course on Church Planting in Monterrey, Mexico, beginning Sunday, January 18, and continuing through Tuesday, January 20. The course is being taught at the Theological Institute of Ministry [Mission to the World (MTW) in Northern Mexico] and will be attended by pastors from all over Mexico.

Dr. Milton will preach Sunday morning at Cumbres del Rey (Summit's King Church) from 1 Timothy 4, a sermon entitled "A Ministry Approved by God." Then the class will begin that evening. The classes will cover biblical strategies for church planting, taken from Acts and many of the Pastoral Epistles. The lectures will deal with theological and pastoral issues as well as the challenges in church planting.

Former Senior Pastor of the historic First Presbyterian Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Milton also founded two churches and a Christian school. Before attending seminary he was an executive with two Fortune 500 companies, and a top-secret linguist in the Navy. In November 2007 he accepted the call to become President of Reformed Theological Seminary. Dr. Milton is the author of 9 books including his autobiography: *What God Starts, God Completes: Help and Hope for Hurting People* (Christian Focus Publications, 2007). His teaching can be heard on select radio stations in the US and over the Internet at www.thecall.rts.edu. Milton often illustrates his sermons with original songs. Music for Missions has released two CDs, "He Shall Restore" and "Follow Your Call", also available through iTunes. He resides in the Charlotte area with his wife and son.
