President of Seminary to Speak in Hopewell

Dr. Michael A. Milton to teach at West End Presbyterian Church

[HOPEWELL, VA—October 3, 2008]—Dr. Michael A. Milton, President and Professor of Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC, will speak at West End Presbyterian Church in Hopewell on Sunday October 12th. His sermon will be taken from selected passages from the Book of Daniel and will be entitled, “This is Your Destiny!”

The pastor, Rev. Collins, said, “Churches are battling the emphasis of quantity over quality and church growth over church health. We are excited to hear challenging words from Dr. Milton about the priority of character in leadership and the goal of spiritual healthy and growing churches.”

Formerly Senior Pastor of the historic First Presbyterian Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee, Milton also founded two churches and a school. Once an executive with two Fortune 50 companies, he was a top-secret linguist in the Navy. He accepted the call to become President of Reformed Theological Seminary in November 2007. Dr. Milton is the author of 9 books including *What God Starts, God Completes: Help and Hope for Hurting People* (Christian Focus Publications, 2007). His teaching can be heard on select radio stations in the US and over the Internet at www.thecall.rts.edu. Milton often illustrates his sermons through original songs and has released one CD on the label Music for Missions called “He Shall Restore,” available through iTunes. He resides in the Charlotte area with his wife and son.
